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Cloud gazing

This is a great activity to do when children are a little tired after an energetic game.

- Find a shaded space in the grass to lie back and look at the clouds. Watch them change shape and move.
- What do they look like? What pictures can you find in the clouds...?
- Can you make a story up around the things you see?
- Take turns in creating the next line of the story and see how creative you can get.
