- Go outside and start gathering sticks and twigs from the ground around you.
- Ask the children about their sticks (be prepared for questions about where they came from and why they're on the ground!).
- Challenge your children's imagination to see what they can build. You could start them off by suggesting shapes, patterns or structures.
- Perhaps they could build a simple twig tower. Or maybe a magical fairy house.
- If they're feeling adventurous they could build their own den.
