Scottish Autism	Clackmannanshire	£2,500	ASN Pilot	Scottish Autism's project will focus on outdoor loose parts play with opportunities available in their environment, the local community and can be used by families at home. This project will work with young people who are autistic and for almost all there is a significant difference between their chronological age and the developmental levels at which they function.
